ADULTS (≥16 Years of Age)	CHILDREN (<16 Years of Age)
<p>Order the following tests for all new adult patients at the refugee clinic:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ CBC ○ Hemoglobinopathy Screen (includes Ferritin and Iron) ○ Heb B Serology ○ Hep C Serology ○ HIV ○ Syphilis ○ Varicella IgG ○ Urine for Gonorrhoea and Chlamydia ○ Strongyloides Serology ○ Stool for O + P and PCR x 1 (if symptomatic) ○ TST or QFT (for patients aged 6 months to 50 years) ○ G6PD Deficiency Screen <p>Other Tests:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Women: B12, TSH, Rubella (if planning pregnancy), consider lead level ○ Tests as indicated: HbA1C, Lipids, FIT, Mammogram, PSA, PAP Smear, Bone Mineral Density Test, EKG, Chest X-Ray, Creatinine ○ Any testing required to evaluate symptoms ○ For patients with clinical symptoms, remember to keep P. vivax and cutaneous leishmaniasis on Ddx. 	<p>Order the following tests for all new child patients at the refugee clinic:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ CBC ○ Hemoglobinopathy Screen (includes Ferritin and Iron) ○ Heb B Serology ○ Hep C Serology ○ HIV (if clinically indicated or risk factors present) ○ Syphilis (if >15 years of age, sexually active or history of abuse) ○ Varicella IgG (if >13 years of age) ○ Urine for Gonorrhoea and Chlamydia (if sexually active or history of abuse) ○ Strongyloides Serology ○ Stool for O + P and PCR x 1 (if symptomatic or <5 years of age) ○ TST or QFT (for patients aged 6 months to 50 years) ○ G6PD Deficiency Screen <p>Other Tests:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Consider lead level
